As of this morning, all the Chem-Bio e-mails are backed up on a server. That includes every e-mail from an RO inquiring about a veteran. They go back to 2002, and folders that belonged to Joyce Greaving. The e-mails about veterans are organized by the type of exposure (SHAD, MG, CBRNE, Radiation, Whitecoat) with the subfolders having the veteran's name. All e-mails to and from DoD are also there.

There is one issue that will need to be considered at some point. While the information can't be lost, now that it is on a server, you still will need help getting access to many files because of digital signatures and encryption. Also, the Defense Health Support Directorate now has Outlook and PKI. As of today, every e-mail with Roy Finno or Dee Dodson Morris at DoD will be encrypted.

But nothing can be lost from today forward.
