Here is the response from DoD after reviewing the files you submitted on

"Service member claims to have been exposed to mustard agents while performing training exercises. He claims he went into gas chambers filled with mustard agent and remained in these chambers for five minutes before masking. This occurred several times a week over a period of months. Individual also claims that he entered mustard filled chambers to 'check out' repaired gas masks. Individual has no records to verify this claim as they were burned in the archives fire. He does submit a "buddy statement" which does support some of the service member's claims but never states that the gas chamber was filled with mustard agent. Army training at the time used tear agents or chlorine not mustard agent in the gas chamber exercises. While not discounting the possibility that the individuals repeated exposure to tear agent or chlorine might be the cause of his health problems we do not consider the service member as being exposed to mustard agent "
