HEALTH CARE INJUNCTION  
ORDER**

UPON CONSIDERATION of the parties’ submissions in response to the Court’s Order of February 8, 2016 (ECF No. 572) regarding the issuance of an injunction to provide medical care in accordance with Army Regulation 70-25, the record of this case, and good cause appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Army is required to provide medical care pursuant to Army Regulation 70-25 to individuals who, while serving in the armed forces, were test subjects in any testing program in which humans were exposed to a chemical or biological substance for the purpose of studying or observing the effects of such exposure, that was sponsored, overseen, directed, funded, and/or conducted by the Department of the Army, and who have an injury or illness that the Army determines is the “proximate result” of such testing participation.
